














Benefits for the Unbeliever

Public Preaching vs. Personal Witness

- Both methods are found in scripture
- Each method holds an equal importance
- "Preach"
 - There are 4 different words used in 1
 Corinthians 1
 - All hold a different meaning and significance



"For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to **PREACH** the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect."

1 Corinthians 1:17

Meaning: To Evangelize

To make the gospel known by every available means

Same word used when Phillip spoke to the Ethiopian Eunuch



"For the **PREACHING** of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God."

1 Corinthians 1:18

Meaning: The Word

The person we preach

Same word used in John 1:1



"For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of **PREACHING** to save them that believe."

1 Corinthians 1:21

Meaning: discharge; the result of preaching
The actual results and truths of the gospel



"But we **PREACH** Christ crucified..."

1 Corinthians 1:23

Meaning: A public declaration by a herald
An evangelist who preaches the gospel

Occurs **61** times in the NT

Fulfill Our Purpose

- It's a COMMAND
 - "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel"
- It should be a DESIRE

After this Jesus revealed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias, and he revealed himself in this way....Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him we will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. Just as day was breaking, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus.....

Jesus said to them, "Children, do you have any fish? They answered him, "No.". He said to them, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish. That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, "It is the Lord!"






Benefits to the Local Church


How does preaching the gospel and focusing on gospel outreach benefit the local church?
